Ferrari Dino 246 GTB, 1972

Considered by many to be the prettiest Ferrari ever built, the Dino won worldwide acclaim as a high point of 1970s automotive styling and became one of the most fashionable cars of the age. It was Enzo Ferrari's tribute to his son Alfredo, who died of a kidney disease, and was intended to rival Porsche's 911. Although unusually fitted with a 2,418cc six-cylinder engine instead of the customary Ferrari V12, the 148mph top speed made possible by Pininfarina's sleek, aerodynamic design.

Aston Martin DB5 Convertible, 1964

The DB5 is probably the most famous Aston Martin ever produced thanks to its role in several James Bond films, beginning with 'Goldfinger' in 1964. The car used in that film was the original DB5 prototype, with another standard car taking over for the stunts. With sales exceeding 1,000 in just over two years of production, the DB5 is also one of the most successful Astons in the company's long history, despite costing twice as much as the Jaguar E-Type when it first went on sale in 1963.

Austin Mini Cooper S, 1963

The Cooper is one of the most stylish, widely respected and universally loved of all classic cars. It is probably best remembered for winning the Monte Carlo Rally three times – or four times if you include the dubious disqualification by the French for having the wrong lightbulbs in 1966 – and for its starring role in 'The Italian Job'. The published performance figures were somewhat misleading because the Mini's ability to corner without slowing down set it in a class of its own.

Lamborghini Countach LP400, 1976

The Countach was unveiled at the Geneva Motor Show in 1971, replacing the legendary Miura. It became the definitive supercar for a generation of car-obsessed teenagers. The breathtaking styling was the work of Marcello Gandini, of Bertone fame, and the shape was a riot of creative genius that ignored all established rules of car design. The styling evolved throughout the car's 16-year lifespan, with the Countach gaining spoilers for downforce, and vents for engine and brake cooling as power increased.

Hispano-Suiza Boulogne, 1922

In 1919, luxury car manufacturer Hispano-Suiza began production of their H6 model. The H6 used a 6.6-litre, 135hp engine inspired by the company's aero engine, which had powered over 50% of Allied biplanes during WW1. In response to requests for a racing version, Hispano-Suiza produced just five very special cars with a shortened wheelbase and more power. Top speed was over 120mph, which no doubt helped this particular car, driven by Paul Bablot, to famously win the 1922 Boulogne Grand Prix.

Porsche 928 S, 1985

The Porsche 928 is a luxury grand tourer produced from 1978 to 1995, blending high performance with refined comfort. 928s are instantly recognisable for their aerodynamic design, including pop-up headlights and a sleek, wide body. Unlike Porsche's traditional rear-engine 911, the 928 features a front engine, rear-drive layout and is powered by a water-cooled V8. While it has not achieved the same iconic status as the 911, the 928 has gained a dedicated following.

Mercedes-Benz 300 SL Roadster, 1957

The SL was born of American demand for a roadster version of the iconic 1954 Gullwing Coupe. A smaller fuel tank made space for the roof to fold down flat, while the SL's sills were lowered for ease of access, creating a low-slung aerodynamic body. Suspension changes gave the roadster a more comfortable ride and the fuel injected 2,996cc straight-six engine's output was increased to 225 horsepower. Highly sought after by collectors today.

De Tomaso first announced its new Pantera in 1969, a model that was to remain in limited production for the next 25 years. All De Tomaso cars offer a wonderful mixture of exotic supercar styling and American muscle-car performance, courtesy of their Italian-designed bodywork and potent but reliable US Ford V8 engines. The example shown here is a very rare 200 SE, one of a limited edition of just 41 cars with bodywork remodelled by Marcello Gandini.

MGA Roadster, 1956

Launched in September 1955, the MGA was the first of the 'modern' sporting MGs. Compared to its predecessor the TF, which still sported old-fashioned running boards, the Le Mans-inspired bodywork of the A was positively futuristic. The smooth bonnet and sloping wings were aerodynamically effective, helping to increase top speed to three figures and usefully improving fuel consumption. As the first new MG to be produced following the merger of Nuffield and Austin.

Chevrolet Camaro Z28, 1979

The 1979 Chevrolet Camaro Z28 is an iconic muscle car from the late 1970s, known for its aggressive styling and potent performance. The Z28 offers a balance of speed, handling and bold aesthetics, with distinctive features including a unique front grille, a bonnet-mounted air induction scoop, flared fenders, and a neat, integrated tail spoiler. Power comes from a 350 cubic inch (5.7-litre) V8 engine, producing around 175hp and 270lb-ft of torque.

Honda NSX, 1999

The NSX, short for New Sports eXperimental, is one of the world's most reliable and refined mid-engined supercars, and a true competitor for the likes of Ferrari and Porsche, yet it remains one of the most underrated, being ignored by many buyers for whom the appeal of a big-name badge is all important. Honda's success in F1 played a major role in the development of the all-aluminium, VTEC-engined NSX, and the late Ayrton Senna was heavily involved in the early testing sessions leading up to the launch in 1990.

Ford GT40 (replica) 1966

The GT40, named after the height of the car in inches, was Ford's first attempt to dominate endurance racing, particularly the 24 Hours of Le Mans. Developed in response to a failed bid to purchase Ferrari, Ford's engineers created a sleek, low-slung car, based on the British Lola Mk.6 GT chassis, and fitted with a powerful and reliable Ford V8 engine. While the 1964 debut at Le Mans ended in disappointment, it laid the foundation for Ford's legendary 1-2-3 victory in 1966.
